---

I'm Evgeni Golov, the Debian maintainer of PokerTH, you have mailed me about that issue.

m.hataj wrote:

there must be something wrong with the package from getdeb.net.

As far as I can remember, we had that problem in Debian too. I think it was because PokerTH was compiled against Qt4 4.2 but running with Qt4 4.3 (or was it 4.3 and 4.4?).

Could you please post the output of the following two commands?

```
dpkg -l "libqt4*"
apt-cache show pokerth
```

Oh, and by the way: Marco and I are the Debian maintainers of PokerTH, we are not affiliated with getdeb.net in any way, thus mailing us about problems with getdeb.net packages is not allways usefull (getdeb.net just uses our packages recompiled for Ubuntu, which can break as you can see here).
